Green Initiatives at NIE

Initiatives by DED colleagues

Our colleagues at DED have been working on continuously improving energy conservation at the NIE campus. Do you know that NIE has the lowest Energy Use Intensity, or EUI, which is an indicator of energy efficiency among IHLs in Singapore? To promote energy conservation, DED has implemented a Facility Booking system coupled with motion sensors to control the air-conditioning system. They have also updated the central air-conditioning system to improve indoor air quality and efficiency with air filters and Ultraviolet (UV) lights. In addition, in an effort to save water and energy, they have installed efficient water taps and upgraded cooling towers.

NIE's energy saving efforts have seen a 54% reduction in NIE's energy consumption, which represents an accumulative reduction of 47,000 Tons of CO2 emission. They cannot have achieved these results without the help of NIE colleagues' help and cooperation! Thank you for having the good habit of turning things off when they are not in use.

DED will continue to work on the deployment of solar energy and improving the recycling services at NIE, including e-waste and possibly food waste. Stay tuned for more details!



What more can I do to help? To further help conserve energy, each of us can also play a part! For example, the next time you leave the office, please continue to remember to turn off the lights. If you share an office space with other colleagues, you can check to see if other colleagues are still around when you leave. Please switch off any equipment or devices when not in use. You can also bring recyclables to the closest recycling bin around your block.

Green FAQ

Q: I am always confused about what can or cannot be recycled. Send help!

While most of us know that items such as newspapers and glass bottles are recyclable, there are also items that we aren't sure what to do about. For example, dirty bottles, plastic bags, take-out containers. What do we do with these? For a quick guide, please see the following flowchart that NEA has prepared. Q: I buy buns a lot at the bakery and I feel bad for using so many plastic bags every time I go. What can I do to reduce the use of plastic at a bakery?

You can ask the staff to put them all in one bag or put the same kind of bun in the same bag. If you go to a bakery regularly (e.g., every morning), why not bring a container with you next time? Another tip is to reuse the bag if your bun isn't a messy one like the one with pork floss. Next time you finish your bun, don't throw the bag away; you can save it for the next day. Regardless, make sure to wash your hands before you eat!
