The objective of this facility is to provide an interactive and collaborative learning environment for both staff and trainee teachers. Some of the activities that you can enjoy here are:

- Access CD-ROMs using PCs and notebooks via wired or wireless technology
- Watch VCD / DVD programmes
- Listen to a music CD
- View a digitised programme on the Digital Video Management System (DVMS).

This is a pilot Video-on-Demand (VOD) service.

You can do all the above by yourself or as a group gathered around the specially designed tables or at the lounge area which has an audio visual system with plasma screens.

- Conduct discussions (not too loud, please) in a conducive environment over a drink or
- Simply take a break to re-charge yourself for the next class or activity.
