The workshop on "Common Threads as a Resource for Learning Mathematics"

Ms Mary Harris, a Visiting Fellow attached to the Department of Mathematics, Statistics and Computing, University of London Institute of Education, visited NIE in early September this year. She conducted numerous talks and workshops from 4 to 6 September '91 at the NIE Campus.

A series of workshops on "Common Threads as a Resource for Learning Mathematics" was also conducted by Ms Harris for Postgraduate Diploma Programme students.

The talks and workshops conducted by Ms Harris were organised in conjunction with the Common Threads Exhibition held at the Bukit Timah Campus from 2 to 6 September. The exhibition highlighted the wealth of mathematics that exist in the design and production of textiles.
