
An Agreement for Collaboration between Nanyang Technological University (NTU) and Loughborough University of Technology (LUT) in the Establishment of the National Institute of Education (NIE)

An agreement for collaboration between NTU and LUT on matters connected with the establishment of NIE was signed on 2nd July 1991 at 10.00 am at the Conference Room of the NIE, Oei Tiong Ham Building.

The Agreement, signed by Dr Cham Tao Soon, President on behalf of NTU and Prof D. E. N. Davies, Vice-Chancellor, on behalf of LUT, formalised the collaboration between NTU and LUT.

Under the terms of the agreement, LUT is to provide guidance and expertise to ensure the success of the new degree programmes as well as to establish the credibility and standing of the NIE's academic programmes. Three main areas of assistance have been identified namely: I) the design of new academic courses and the validation of their contents and standards.

- 2) the maintenance and control of the quality as these courses develop, and
- 3) the recruitment of well-qualified academic staff to uphold the high standards desired.
