To commemorate NIE's 60 years of teacher education, eleven beginning teachers take on the task of writing candidly about their experiences and the challenges faced in teaching for the publication aptly titled, "Teaching is HeartWork".

NIE holds the **Caring Teacher Awards 2010**, where schools and parents nominate teachers who display care and concern for the academic, moral, social, emotional and mental welfare of their students.
